
## **Preparing Your Pond for Winter**

Here in Michiana, it is time to begin preparing your pond for winter. If you follow these basic steps, your pond will survive our winter to thrive again next spring.

- Clean all pumps and filters and add Microbe-lift winter prep solution and run pumps to circulate. This beneficial bacteria will work all winter.
- 2. Give your pond a fall cleaning. You will want to clean the mulm (debris) from the bottom of the pond. It is essential that all the old leaves and mulm are removed! This is where the aeronomas bacteria and parasites live if you let them. Clean before adding any treatments. If the pond does not have any large amounts of debris, do not empty the entire pond. Change 30% of the water and be sure to check the PH and ammonia levels. Prepare your pond netting for use and install before the leaves begin to fall.
- Clean all filters, skimmers, etc. and remove if they are located where they could freeze. Stop feeding fish when the water temperature gets into the 50's. Clean your floating de-icer and plug in before the water begins to freeze.
- 4. Now is the time to remove and compost all floating and tropical pond plants.
- 5. Prune all dead foliage and move plants to the bottom of the pond.


# **Botanically Correct Christmas Trees**
